Implementation and Pricing for QPR Online Training

When installed and sustained as recommended, QPR for Schools creates a systems approach to suicide risk reduction based upon evidence-based best practice education and training. Training is deliverable to all members of a defined population and is matched to the level of responsibility each member has for the safety of others.

Implementation steps:

1. Leadership signs a 3-year unlimited use training license for all stakeholders and assigns a program coordinator to learn to use our Learning Management System to monitor and evaluate QPR online training. Traditional classroom QPR training is also available, but is priced differently.
2. All school psychologists, nurses, and social workers receive advanced certificate training. This training is in suicide risk detection, assessment and management and deliverable online. If not from the QPR Institute, this training should be one of the three “best practice registered” courses offered by the QPR Institute/Eastern Washington University, the Suicide Prevention Resource Center or the American Association of Suicidology. Ideally, community-based mental health professionals who receive at-risk student referrals should also be trained.
3. All school teachers, support staff, employees, and volunteers are trained in QPR online (or face-to-face if elected) and supported by Certified QPR Instructors or mental health professionals within the school for follow-up classroom sessions to answer questions, rehearse crisis response, and review policy and procedures.
4. Per the school’s own policy and implementation strategy, parents and students are trained in the following order: seniors, juniors, sophomores, freshmen. Training may be delivered online to small groups of students in computer labs or in health classes. Mandatory, or optional, parents may be invited to share their child’s QPR learning account.
5. To enhance community involvement, the school may recruit concerned community members by extending the academic discount code “QPRO” (enter at prompt from “QPR Gatekeeper Training for Suicide Prevention – Enroll Now” at www.qprinstitute.com.) Stakeholders receive a 30% educational discount.

In summary, referral networks are established and trained *first*, employees trained *second*, and students and parents are trained *third*.
